




## Key ingredient

### How to use















- 2. Apply an appropriate amount evenly to all areas of your face.

- 5. This product is for nighttime use, so apply it during your evening skincare routine.



#### **Precautions**

The usage frequency varies depending on the concentration.

For Exoblanc Spicule Cream, it is recommended to use once a week.

- Perform a patch test by applying a small amount to sensitive areas such as the inside of your arm, under your chin, or behind your earlobes to check for skin irritation or allergic reactions.
- The product contains needle-like spicule ingredients, which may cause a tingling sensation upon application. This reaction is normal as the needle creates tiny punctures in the skin.
- If you have viral infections like herpes, use the product only after full recovery and healing.
- Avoid applying near the sensitive eye area and apply cautiously.
- Do not use in conjunction with devices that may irritate the skin or after dermatological treatments.
